ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND REQUIREMENTS

Applications should be submitted by March 15 for admission to the program the following January (Spring semester).

- A. Applicants must successfully complete all ECU foundations and CLS prerequisite courses prior to entering the program. Course grades earned in CLS prerequisite courses must be a "C" (73%) or higher.
 - General Biology: BIOL 1150/1151
 - Survey of Human Anatomy & Physiology: BIOL 2130
 - Microbiology: BIOL 2110/2111
 - General Chemistry I: CHEM 1150/1151
 - General Chemistry II: CHEM 1160/1161
 - Organic & Biochemistry for the Allied Health Sciences: CHEM 1130
 - College Algebra: MATH 1065
 - Statistics: PSYC 2101 or MATH 2228

In some instances, a higher-level course may be substituted for a program prerequisite. Consult the CLS Department Chair for additional information.

- B. In order to be considered for admission into the professional phase of the CLS program, students must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in each of the following:
 - Cumulative GPA
 - All Biology coursework
 - All Chemistry coursework

Note that for courses taken multiple times, **all grades earned** are used to calculate the Biology and Chemistry coursework GPAs.

- B. Prerequisite courses must have been completed within 7 years of application to the program.
- C. Exceptions to the above requirements are rare, and must be approved by the CLS department chair.

A completed application includes the following:

- A. Department of Clinical Laboratory Science application form, including a written statement describing your concept of the profession of Clinical Laboratory Science, and why you have chosen to apply.
- B. If not currently enrolled at ECU, transcripts of all grades from other educational institutions.

Admission to the CLS program is competitive. Applicants will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- A. Grade point average: overall and in science courses.
- B. Interview: interviews are conducted by at least two CLS faculty members. Applicants are questioned on their knowledge and perception of the profession, study habits, and goals related to the laboratory profession. Interviewers strive to ascertain the extent of student's motivation and interest in the profession, technical abilities, maturity, and sense of responsibility. Applicants who have met the minimum admission requirements will be contacted for an interview during the spring semester.
- C. Number of college-level courses taken at ECU or other 4-year accredited university/college.
- D. Laboratory or other medical experience, if any.

Program acceptance/non-acceptance letters will be sent to applicants via e-mail prior to registration for Spring Semester. Acceptance into the program is provisional, contingent upon successful completion of in-progress or pending coursework.

Application materials must be submitted electronically on or before March 15.

Applications received after this date will be reviewed at the end of the spring and summer semesters. Late applications will be considered on a space-available basis.
